- A detailed resume.
- A minimum of one letter of recommendation, to a maximum of three. Preference will be given to letters from educational faculty.
- Proof of registration in a full-time or part-time mining, mineral, metallurgy or geoscience program at a Canadian post-secondary institution.

Applications are scored out of 100 points in accordance with the following four evaluation categories:

- 1. Application form 20 points
- 2. Video 50 points
- 3. Detailed resume 20 points
- 4. Letter(s) of recommendation 10 points

A copy of your complete application package (form and attachments) is to be sent electronically to scholarship@mihr.ca by no later than September 30 of each year. Packages can be sent using a file transfer service such as WeTransfer or DropBox. Applicants will receive email confirmation that their application has been received. Late and incomplete submissions will not be accepted or reviewed.

The successful candidates will be advised of their award by approximately October 30 of each year. Scholarship funds will be made available to the successful applicant between November 15 and January 15 of that same academic year.

All applicants will receive email notification whether their application is successful or not.
